They are particularly suitable for age-related joint degeneration, supplementary treatment of degenerative symptoms of the musculoskeletal system, and as a preventive measure for young dogs of large breeds or dogs involved in sports or other activities that stress the joints.



Does your dog have a dull, dry coat, skin irritation, allergies or sore paws? Zinc amino acid chelate, biotin, omega-3 fatty acids and brewer's yeast are the active ingredients in our **DERM**-Tabs. They complement each other with their positive effect on skin and coat metabolism.



Frail, sensitive or stressed dogs benefit particularly from our **VITAL**-Tabs with vitamin C and beta-glucans from brewer's yeast. In young animals, **VITAL**-Tabs can help to strengthen the body's own defence system during the immunity gap after weaning.



If your dog is overweight, we recommend **FIBER-Tab**s. High-fibre ballast and L-carnitine support weight loss in overweight dogs and can also be given over the long term to prevent weight gain in older or less active dogs.



AGE-Tabs should be considered at the first signs of age-related problems with your dog's eyes or circulation, or lack of vitality in mature dogs.
